- 1.) This request is to replace existing high-bay light fixtures with new (6) tube fluorescent high bay fixtures. This job is located in Bldg 71, Rail Gun Facility, at the Naval Research Laboratory in Washington, DC.
- 2.) The contractor shall provide all necessary labor, equipment, parts and supplies to: remove the existing high bay light fixtures suspended from Rail Gun Facility ceiling, to include 2 suspended light fixture clusters mounted on boards, engineer and calculate lighting space for optimum uniformity of light coverage, decide quantity, placement and locations of new light fixtures and install type 6 tube, high output fluorescent light fixtures.
- 3.) Use Existing Electrical circuits originating from panel board H and existing switches for operation of the new lighting fixtures.
- 4.) Flattened Cardboard Products. Only Card-Board is permitted to be disposed of on NRL property in this manner.
- 5.) Before the Contractor may begin any work/phases of the job, the safety plans need to be submitted and approved by the NRL Safety Office, Code 3540.
